News of Jackson Health System

Jackson West's expansion plans are continuing to grow. In March 2015, the Miami-Dade Board of County Commissioners supported the initiative to purchase a 27-acre parcel of land in Doral just west of the Palmetto Expressway and north of Northwest 25th Street as the site for a 100-bed hospital, a leading-edge outpatient medical campus with an emergency center, doctors' offices, and pediatric specialists. The facility will serve Doral, Westchester, Sweetwater, Hialeah, and Miami Lakes. In addition to greater convenience for patients, Jackson West will give our physician partners in West Miami-Dade County the option to practice closer to home. The City of Doral recognized our new plan as one that will provide essential access to important services and amenities, which is vital for a growing community. Jackson West is set to open in 2018.

Dedication of the Sandy A. Sears Surgical Center at Jackson North

Jackson North Medical Center celebrated the dedication of its surgical center in honor of its former chief administrative officer, Sandy A. Sears, who had a distinguished career for 39 years at Jackson Health System and retired in 2014 after leading Jackson North for more than seven years. Sears has long been considered a role model for community service, making it an easy choice for the Miami-Dade Board of County Commissioners to approve Resolution R-646-14 and ultimately rename a signature portion of the hospital in her honor.
